
40 Years of the Alta Children's Center

Ms. Ilse has done a complete renovation of the center and opened the center's first summer camp in 2019. Ms. Ilse and her team run a clean, professional, and reliable center in both the winter and summer.

Many memories have been made over the course of the Alta Children's Center's 40 years. There have been several interlodge events over the years resulting in guests staying at the playroom.

An interlodge event is when the snow level and avalanche danger are too high for patrons to be outdoors while avalanche mitigation is taking place. Ms. Wilson has fed and hosted many guests in her 7 years as owner. As said by previous owner, Joan Nichol, in 1995 there was such a big snowstorm that it resulted in 95 guests sleeping over during an interlodge. One of the 95 guests was a woman in active labor.
